$DAY \ 1$ - basel (breisach)

Arrive at EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg, where you will be transferred to the ship.

$DAY\ 2$ – breisach (Kayserberg and Riquewihr or Colmar)

DAY 4 - mannheim (speyer)
